

Retreat Information

We are very excited that you have decided to sign up for Family Camp! We have put together some helpful information for your experience here at Dickey Lake Bible Camp.

Check In

Check in will begin at **4 PM on Friday** in the dining hall. At this time, you will sign-in and find your accommodation information. **Dinner will begin at 6pm.** You may enjoy and explore camp before dinner.

Check Out

The retreat will conclude after lunch on Sunday. We ask that you clean your cabin space and leave it ready for the next group.

Camp Emergency Contact

If you need to have anyone reach you in case of an emergency, they can contact the **Camp Office** at 406-882-4572.

Camp Store

The Camp Store will be open during specific times during the weekend. We accept cash, check, and cards. The camp store has DLBC apparel, novelties, drinks, candy, and snacks.

Cell Phones

Cell phone service is extremely limited at camp and we do have limited WIFI for guests if they need it. Please plan accordingly.

Dietary Concerns

If a family member has dietary concerns and you have not yet indicated this on their registration form, please contact the camp in advance so the kitchen staff can make appropriate meal arrangements.

Boats

Launching of boats from DLBC property and tying up boats on the camp dock is prohibited. They also may not drive through the designated swim area. However, boats may be tied on the south side of the beach and can be launched at the North Shore Park located off Hwy 93 and Trego Rd.

Dog Policy

Dogs are permitted to stay at camp if they remain within the confines of a personal vehicle or RV/Camper. Dogs must be leashed during walks at all times and are not permitted on the main camp lawn area or on the lake side of campus. Owners are required to clean up after their dogs. If a dog becomes disruptive of camp programming or injures anyone, the owners will take full responsibility as well as being asked to remove the dog from camp property.

Activities

Camp offers a variety of activities and you are welcome to use our equipment or bring your own. Packing List
